Administrator's Physical Loss Notification

News Release | Iowa | May 28, 2024

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Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

Impacted Area: Iowa

Administrator Notification Code: N1714

Application Deadline: January 27, 2025

Triggering Disaster: Tornadoes and thunderstorms that occurred April 26-27, 2024.

Primary Counties Eligible: Clarke, Harrison, Mills, Polk, Pottawattamie, Ringgold, Shelby, Union

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible: Adair, Adams, Audubon, Boone, Carroll, Cass, Crawford, Dallas, Decatur, Fremont, Jasper, Lucas, Madison, Marion, Monona, Montgomery, Page, Story, Taylor, Warren, Wayne.

Other States Also Eligible:

Missouri: Harrison and Worth Counties

Nebraska: Burt, Cass, Douglas, Sarpy, Washington Counties
