Federal Emergency Management Agency Designates Eight Iowa Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas Due to Severe Storms and Tornadoes

This Presidential disaster declaration allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation, or to refinance certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available, and repayment ability.

Presidential Major Disaster Designation M4779

Impacted Area: Iowa

Triggering Disaster: Severe Storms and Tornadoes occurring April 26, 2024, through April 27, 2024

Application Deadline: January 14, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Clarke, Harrison, Mills, Polk, Pottawattamie, Ringgold, Shelby, Union

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

Iowa: Adair, Adams, Audubon, Boone, Carroll, Cass, Crawford, Dallas, Decatur, Fremont, Jasper, Lucas, Madison, Marion, Monona, Montgomery, Page, Story, Taylor, Warren, Wayne

Missouri: Harrison and Worth

Nebraska: Burt, Cass, Douglas, Sarpy, Washington
