USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected in 8 Oklahoma Counties by Recent Natural Disasters

Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

Impacted Area: Arkansas

Triggering Disaster, 1: Excessive rain, flash flooding, high winds, and lightning that occurred April 25, 2024 through April 29, 2024

Application Deadline: February 7, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Benton, Carroll, Franklin, Madison, White

Triggering Disaster, 2: Hail, high winds, and a tornado that occurred on May 7, 2024 through May 9, 2024 **Primary Counties Eligible:** Boone, Crawford, Washington **Contiguous Counties Eligible:**

Arkansas: Benton, Carroll, Franklin, Madison, Marion, Newton, Searcy, Sebastian

Missouri: Taney

Oklahoma: Adair, Sequoyah

Triggering Disaster, 3: Excessive rain, flash flooding, hail, high winds, lightning, and tornadoes that occurred May 21, 2024 through May 26, 2024

Primary Counties: Baxter, Benton, Boone, Carroll, Lee, Madison, Marion, Prairie, White

Contiguous Counties:

Arkansas: Arkansas, Cleburne, Crawford, Crittenden, Faulkner, Franklin, Fulton, Independence, Izard,

Triggering Disaster, 1: Excessive rain, flash flood that occurred on May 4, 2024

Triggering Disaster, 2: Hail and high wind that occurred on May 9, 2024

Primary County: Lamar

Triggering Disaster, 3: Hail, high winds, and a tornado that occurred on May 12, 2025 through May 29, 2024 **Primary County:** Bell

Contiguous Counties: Burnet, Coryell, Falls, Lampasas, McLennan, Milam, Williamson

Triggering Disaster, 4: Tornado and high winds that occurred May 16, 2024

Primary Counties: Austin, Harris, Waller

Contiguous Counties: Brazoria, Chambers, Colorado, Fayette, Fort Bend, Galveston, Grimes, Liberty, Montgomery, Washington, Wharton

Triggering Disaster, 5: Excessive rain, flash flood, hail, and high winds that occurred on May 23, 2024 **Primary Counties:** Grayson

Contiguous Counties:

Oklahoma: Bryan, Love, Mashall

Texas: Collin, Cooke, Denton, Fannin

Triggering Disaster, 6: Flash flood, hail, and high winds that occurred on May 28, 2024

Primary County: Terrell

Contiguous Counties: Brewster, Crockett, Pecos, Val Verde

Triggering Disaster, 7: A tornado that occurred May 25, 2024 through May 26, 2024

Primary Counties: Collin, Cooke, Denton, Montague

Texas: Clay, Dallas, Fannin, Grayson, Hunt, Jack, Rockwall, Tarrant, Wise
