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This Presidential disaster declaration allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation, or to refinance certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available, and repayment ability.

Impacted Area: Oklahoma

Triggering Disaster: Severe storms, straight-line winds, and tornadoes that occurred May 19 to May 28th 2024

Application Deadline: February 14, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Blaine, Caddo, Custer, Delaware, Jackson, Mayes, Muskogee, Rogers

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

Arkansas: Benton

Missouri: McDonald

Disaster 1, Amendment 1: Severe storms, straight-line winds, and tornadoes that occurred May 24, 2024 through May 27, 2024

Application Deadline: February 14, 2025

Primary County Eligible: Roger Mills, Woods

Oklahoma: Alfalfa, Beckham, Custer, Dewey, Ellis, Harper, Major, Woodward
