

USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Minnesota Producers in Todd, Waseca, and Stearns County Affected by High Winds, Tornadoes, Excessive Rain, and Hail

<u>Physical loss loans</u> through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

Triggering Disaster 1: High Winds that occurred on July 31, 2024. (N1769)

Application Deadline: April 16, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Todd

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

Minnesota: Cass, Douglas, Morrison, Otter Tail, Stearns, Wadena

Triggering Disaster 2: High Winds that occurred on August 5, 2024. (N1770)

Application Deadline: April 16, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Waseca

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

Minnesota: Blue Earth, Faribault, Freeborn, Le Sueur, Rice, Steele

Triggering Disaster 3: Tornado, Excessive Rain, Hail and High Winds that occurred on August 3, 2024. (N1771)

Application Deadline: April 16, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Stearns

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

Minnesota: Benton, Douglas, Kandiyohi, Meeker, Morrison, Pope, Sherburne, Todd, Wright
