USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Minnesota Producers In Freeborn County Affected by High Winds

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<u>Physical loss loans</u> through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

Impacted Area: Minnesota

Triggering Disaster: Hail and High Winds on September 19, 2024 (N1780)

Application Deadline: May 27, 2025

Primary Counties Eligible: Freeborn

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

Iowa: Winnebago, Worth

Minnesota: Faribault, Mower, Steele, Waseca
