Low-Interest Emergency Loans Available to Producers Affected by Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) extends muchneeded emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters and, in this case, quarantines
through <u>emergency loans</u>. Emergency loans can be used to meet various needs including the
replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation
or refinancing certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available
and repayment ability.

State: Wisconsin

Triggering Disaster Event: Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) from December 13, 2024, through January 13, 2025, quarantine imposed by the Wisconsin Department of Agricultural Trade and Consumer Protection.

Application Deadline: November 6, 2025

Primary Wisconsin Counties Eligible: Barron, Burnett, Kenosha

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

Illinois: Lake, McHenry

Minnesota: Chisago, Pine

Wisconsin: Chippewa, Douglas, Dunn, Polk, Racine, Rusk, St. Croix, Sawyer, Walworth, Washburn
