## USDA Designates Texas Counties (S5967) as Natural Disaster Areas Due to Heat and Winds

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation, or to refinance certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available, and repayment ability.

### Triggering Disaster #1

**Impacted Area:** Texas, New Mexico and Oklahoma

**Triggering Disaster:** Heat and Winds

**Application Deadline:** 12/11/2025

### Primary Counties Eligible:

- **Texas:** Austin, Borden, Briscoe, Concho, Dawson, Dickens, Ector, Fisher, Floyd, Gaines, Garza, Glasscock, Hemphill, Hockley, Howard, Jones, Kent, Lamb, Lynn, Martin, Midland, Mitchell, Nolan, Reagan, Scurry, Taylor, Terry, Upton, Washington, Wheeler, and Yoakum.

### Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

- **New Mexico:** Lea
- **Oklahoma:** Beckham, Ellis, and Roger Mills.
