## USDA Designates Rapides Parish, Louisiana, as a Primary Natural Disaster Area

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through <a href="mailto:emergency loans">emergency loans</a>. Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

State: Louisiana

<u>Triggering Disaster</u>: Winter storm, including ice, that occurred from Feb. 15 through Feb. 21, 2021

Application Deadline: Jan. 10, 2022

Primary Parish Eligible: Rapides

<u>Contiguous Parishes also Eligible</u>: Allen, Avoyelles, Evangeline, Grant, LaSalle, Natchitoches and Vernon
