## USDA Designates Tippecanoe County, Indiana, as a Primary Natural Disaster Area

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

**Impacted Area:** Indiana

**Triggering Disaster:** Frost and freeze that occurred from April 20 through April 22, 2021

**Application Deadline:** July 5, 2022

**Primary County Eligible:** Tippecanoe

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Benton, Carroll, Clinton, Fountain, Montgomery, Warren and White
