## Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected by Natural Disasters (Kansas, Nebraska)

**Emergency Designation | July 19, 2022**

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Physical loss loans can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees and harvested or stored crops and hay.

**State:** Kansas

**Triggering Disaster Event:** Tornado, excessive rain, hail, high winds and lightning that occurred June 6, 2022, through June 11, 2022

**Application Deadline:** March 8, 2023

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Marshall

**Contiguous Areas also Eligible:**

**Kansas:** Nemaha, Pottawatomie, Riley and Washington

**Nebraska:** Gage and Pawnee
