Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected by Natural Disasters (North Dakota, Minnesota, South Dakota)

Emergency Designation | July 19, 2022

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Physical loss loans can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees and harvested or stored crops and hay.

State: North Dakota

<u>Triggering Disaster Event:</u> Excessive rain, flooding, and a flash flood that occurred April 17, 2022, through May 1, 2022. **Application Deadline**: March 8, 2023

Primary Counties Eligible: Barnes, Grand Forks, Pembina, Ransom and Sargent

Contiguous Areas also Eligible:

North Dakota: Cass, Cavalier, Dickey, Griggs, LaMoure, Nelson, Richland, Steele, Stutsman, Traill

and Walsh

Minnesota: Kittson, Marshall and Polk

South Dakota: Brown, Marshall and Roberts
