## Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected by Natural Disasters

Physical loss loans can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees and harvested or stored crops and hay.

Triggering Disaster Event: Tornado, hail and high winds that occurred on July 20, 2022

**Application Deadline**: April 19, 2023

**Primary Counties Eligible**: Sargent

Contiguous Areas also Eligible: North Dakota: Dickey, Ransom and Richland

South Dakota: Brown, Marshall and Roberts
