USDA Designates 13 Louisiana Parishes as Primary Natural Disaster Areas

Five Texas Counties Also Eligible for Assistance

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation, or to refinance certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available, and repayment ability.

According to the [U.S. Drought Monitor](#), these counties suffered from a drought intensity value during the growing season of 1) D2 Drought-Severe for 8 or more consecutive weeks or 2) D3 Drought-Extreme or D4 Drought-Exceptional.

Impacted Area: Texas

Triggering Disaster #1: Drought (Fast Track)

Application Deadline: April 15, 2024

Primary Parishes Eligible: Acadia, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Martin, St. Mary, and Vermilion

Contiguous Parishes Also Eligible: Allen, Assumption, Cameron, Evangeline, Iberville, Jefferson Davis, Point Coupee, St. Landry, Terrebonne, and Vernon

Texas: Newton and Orange

Impacted Area: Texas

Triggering Disaster #2: Drought (Fast Track)

Application Deadline: April 22, 2024

Primary Parishes Eligible: Cameron, Jefferson Davis, Sabine, St. Landry, and Cameron

Contiguous Parishes Also Eligible: Acadia, Allen, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Calcasieu, De Soto, Evangeline, Iberville, Lafayette, Natchitoches, Point Coupee, Rapides, St. Martin, and Vermilion

Texas: Jefferson, Newton, Orange, Sabine, and Shelby
